You may think you know everthing about guns however the MOLECAT<sup>®</sup> unit is not a gun. For successful results READ THE INSTRUCTIONS! Safety first! Observe two safety features that are only released after the unit is securely anchored into the exit hole as explained in steps 13 & 14.


- A. "Clockwise" and "Counter Clockwise" are terms used to describe the use of the Knob on the nondischarging end of MOLECAT® and it is the Knob device by which MOLECAT® is set to discharge.
- B. Hot Plasma discharges from the .27 Cartridge and Firing Barrel at high velocity and can cause serious burns/injury/death to user and bystanders.
- C. Always wear Eye/Hearing safety gear when operating MOLECAT  $^{\! \circ}$  .
- D. DO NOT place anything into Firing Barrel other than a .27 caliber Extermination Cartridge.
- E. DO NOT operate MOLECAT® in an enclosed area.

# Setting Unit & Test Procedure Understanding the two Safety features

IMPORTANT: Do steps 2, 3 & 4 in sequence to allow Trigger Lever to slide forward into slot.

Always point Trigger end down when setting for correct Trigger sensitivity.



For Safety -Remove Firing Barrel: Turn counter clockwise and set aside.



Firmly hold Sleeve.
Rotate Knob firmly
clockwise until
it stops turning.

Trigger Lever for



Holding Sleeve, push Knob down until the Reset Indicator slides into Sleeve.

### Hammer Safety On

Rotate Knob counterclockwise to Safe Line.


The hammer cannot fire the cartridge until rotated past Safe Line.

Go to step 7A to test. Go to step 8 to arm.



The Knob controls the firing mechanism.

Rotating the Knob past the Safe Line sets the unit to fire and is **done only** in **Step #14**.





Rotating the Knob past the Safe Line when **testing** without a Cartridge will damage the Firing Barrel (as shown) and is not covered by the warranty.



Trigger Safety Off:

Turn Trigger Safety left or right to unblock Trigger Lever.



Gently set Trigger Triangle on a stable surface. It will make an audible "SNAP" sound under its own weight.

Reset Indicator pops up to show activation.




#### **SET UNIT**




# **SAFETY FIRST!**

Operating unit requires the use of eye and ear protection. Keep hands away from Firing Barrel after inserting cartridge.





Place Extermination Cartridge into Firing Barrel cavity as shown. Reinsert Firing Barrel into MOLECAT.®



IMPORTANT: Firing Barrel Insert. Correct





## Read SFBag Tip 1

Place entire unit in an inside-out Scent Free Bag. Stir the Trigger end of MOLECAT® in loose soil to add natural scent on the outside of SFBag. Set aside.



No need to shovel! Use a tablespoon to open hole allowing air to flow around unit and into the exit hole. Use a probe to determine direction of the run. See Tip 4 & 5.



Place bagged unit halfway into exit hole. then use Anchor prongs to secure MOLECAT® at the Sleeve and to the side of the exit hole. Allow room to manipulate both Safeties. Read Tip 6.



# **Trigger Safety Off:**

Gently turn Trigger Safety left or right to unblock Trigger Lever. Trigger Safety is now off.

Unit will "snap" if SFBag tension is too tight but cartridge fire is prevented until Step 14. Reset!


## **IMPORTANT:** Steps 13 & 14 must be followed in sequence to avoid premature firing.



### Hammer Safety Off

Carefully rotate Knob counterclockwise to Fire Line. The Hammer can now strike the cartridge and fire.

NOTE: Knob comes off for cleaning when rotated past the Fire Line.



For safety, cover MOLECAT® with a bucket or other cover to protect children & pets. **IMPORTANT:** Allow air to circulate into the hole as shown. A moles' instinct is to close open airway



Unit has fired when Red Reset Indicator appears between the Knob and Sleeve. The Hammer Gauge will disappear. Unit will look like inset example #4 above.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Follow steps 13 and 14 above in sequence or premature firing may happen. Step 13 checks the tension between the trigger and SFBag and for any unseen obstacle that may be Step 14 sets hammer to fire - the last step for arming. in the hole.

Keeping your unit clean and oiled will extend the life of MOLECAT® and keep your warranty valid.

## **Cleaning Procedure**

MOLECAT® is a rugged but very precise product. DO NOT allow dirt build up on the threads. DO NOT force water into the unit. DO NOT allow to stand in water or oil. Follow below cleaning procedure regularly to keep unit in good working condition and to avoid a \$35 factory Cleaning/Repair fee.

Periodic cleaning will extend good operating condition of trigger sensitivity and can be used before full cleaning is needed.

Add a drop of oil into the Trigger Lever slot. Spray WD40 on Firing Barrel threads and wipe soil away from under Soil Cap area. Follow STEP 1 below to clean Hammer Gauge and thread column.

#### Use terrycloth under your work to keep all parts together! Tools needed for cleaning:

Toothbrush, Q-tips, terrycloth, grease (petroleum jelly or lithium), Size "0" Phillips screwdriver, 2" piece of masking tape, WD40 as a cleaning agent and a clean damp washcloth.

#### STEP 1 - Clean Knob / thread column

- 1. Remove Firing Barrel from unit
- 2. Set the unit to SAFE Line and with Trigger Safety on (steps 1-6, page 2). Now rotate the Knob counterclockwise off unit.
- 3. Use a toothbrush or terrycloth to clean and lube threads column with WD40. Wipe Knob for any surface soil.
- 4. Screw Knob clockwise onto unit until it stops turning. Rotate Trigger Safety to unblock Trigger Wire. ROCKER
- 5. Use a toothbrush or terrycloth to clean Firing Barrel threads.

If soil has accumulated into inner working mechanism, continue to Step 2


#### STEP 2 - Disassemble Unit / Clean Parts

- 1. Slide the Soil Cap away, down the Trigger Wire.
- 2. Remove white Trigger Safety Ring.
- 3. Using a #0 screw driver, unscrew (4) small Phillips screws counterclockwise to remove.
- 4. Slide off Sleeve Cover and set aside.
- 5. **NOTE:** there are 4 small parts positioned under Rocker Cover. Remove tape and Rocker Cover, set aside.
- Carefully tap out (2) Rockers and (2) 1/8" Ball Bearings onto terry cloth. Do not remove the 2 roll pins.
- 6. Remove Trigger Wire assembly, set aside.


You are now ready to clean: DO NOT SUBMERSE THE MAIN HOUSING/SLEEVE IN WATER OR OIL Use a soft toothbrush or Q-Tip to clean crevices. Use damp wash cloth and WD-40 to remove any soil build-up on all parts.

#### STEP 3 - Now it's time to re-assemble the unit!

- 1. Place a coat of petroleum jelly or lithium grease in the clean cavity as shown using a Q-tip (picture 3).
- 2. **IMPORTANT:** set (2) Rockers with blunt ends next to roll pins (picture 4 and 5).
- 3. Place Trigger Assembly with O-ring outside of cavity, between Soil Cap & Sleeve (picture 2).
- 4. Insert (2) Ball Bearings in place between trigger wire paddles and rockers (picture 5).
- 5. Place Rocker Cover over cavity. Use clean 2" masking tape: secure to Sleeve (no scotch, duct or electrical tape). **BLUNT END**
- 6. Test unit (steps 1-7A and 7B, page 2). Unit should activate on weight of device only.
- 7. Slide Sleeve Cover back over Sleeve. Hand tighten 4 screws clockwise until flush with sockets. Do not over tighten or Reset Indicator will not slide into Sleeve when operating.
- 8. Slide the Soil Cap in place and screw in Firing Barrel.
- 9. Snap the Trigger Safety back on.
- 10. Test device again after assembly.





# **Important Tips**

One Cartridge + One Scent Free Bag = One Kill.

1. Moles and gophers have an EXTREME sense of smell and hearing just like a dog. For best results rotate the Scent Free Bag (SFBag) inside out to ensure there is no scent that the pest can detect as danger such as flash powder from previous firings or hand oils.

#### Recommended Procedure to turn SFBag inside out:

- a. Grab top opening of SFBag with both hands, thumbs inside.
- b. Stuff outside of SFBag "inside out" with remaining fingers.
- c. Push hand through using thumb and little finger to open up Bag corners. Once inside is out, place Trigger Triangle end of device into one corner of the SFBag. Grab the opposite corner and pull toward the unit to make a "tent" careful to not touch the Trigger half end that inserts into exit hole. This "tent" enlarges the trigger area and will check the tension between Trigger and SFBag. Remember the Trigger is sensitive too much pressure on the Trigger Wire and the device will activate (or "snap") when Trigger Safety is taken off. Good practice is to pull back slightly on unit to relax the trigger tension from SFBag before anchoring.
- 2. The first season using MOLECAT® requires persistence. Keep setting MOLECAT® until the underground defense of decomposing pests has been built around your property, which will repel other incoming pests.
- 3. Use MOLECAT® early in the spring when the young emerge. As the season progresses and as the pests get older, they grow smarter and harder to exterminate. Strategy must be applied when hunting these animals.
- 4. Allowing airflow into the hole instinctively calls the **mole** to the opening to encounter MOLECAT® so open exit hole just enough for a small amount of airflow around the unit.
- **5**. To ensure a good strike, use a probe (like a spoon handle) to indicate there is a straight 8" throat into the exit hole before anchoring.
- **6.** Anchor MOLECAT® securely to the exit hole. The Trigger Wire is sensitive when Step 13 and 14 Safeties are off. Device will fire prematurely if it touches the sides of the hole with any movement. Secure from wobble.
- 7. If the pest buries the unit, this indicates that it has gotten a danger scent. Reread tip #1 above. Use a clothes pin or clamp to close open end of SFBag and help keep soil out.
- **8**. Use different types of scents such as WD40 or fisherman worm scent to confuse a smart **mole**.
- **9**. Worms, air and water are used to bait **moles**. **Moles** smell water and air coming into open exit holes so a cup of water poured into the hole will instinctively call the pest back to investigate.
- 10. Place a night crawler in the open bag, shaking it into the corner and mash it for **mole** bait. Then rotate the SFBag inside out. Messy but it works!
- 11. Gophers, squirrels and rats eat vegetation and need to be baited. They generally leave the exit hole open. Bait a small amount of peanut butter, cheese whiz, or other food extract on the **outside** of SFBag on Trigger Triangle.
- **12**. To remove fired Cartridge, remove the Firing Barrel from the unit and place the Cartridge Punch inside the barrel. Tap Cartridge Punch on a hard surface to dislodge empty shell.
- **13**. Use of construction flags will easily mark the position of MOLECAT®.
- 14. For updated Tips go to www.molecat.com "How To" tab.
- 15. For best results, use 1 MOLECAT® per acre. Dependent on severity of infestation or desire to quickly clear area, two units will work twice as fast.
- **16**. Disguise MOLECAT®! Fold a paper towel in half, lay on loose soil and wet with water. Place foot on towel forcing the soil to penetrate the fibers. Lay soiled towel flat over open hole. Insert towel with trigger into hole.

# **Moving Unfired Unit to Another Hole**

- **Step 1** Before removing Unit from hole: Using index finger and thumb, gently rotate Knob **clockwise** until it stops turning.
- **Step 2** Rotate Trigger Safety to block Trigger Lever forward into slot.
- Step 3 Unit is now safe to move to another hole, follow steps 10-16 to reset.

# **Disarm Unit**

- **Step 1-** Before removing Unit from hole: Using index finger and thumb, gently rotate Knob **clockwise** until it stops turning.
- **Step 2** Rotate Trigger Safety to unblock the Trigger Lever then pull back Trigger Lever out of Slot. Unit is now disarmed and safe to remove.
- **Step 3** Use hands to remove any unspent Cartridge.

  DO NOT use Cartridge Punch to remove unspent Cartridge.

# Storage—IMPORTANT! Release tension on spring when storing

- 1 Disarm Unit. (above)
- 2 Remove the Cartridge from the Firing Barrel.
- 3 IMPORTANT: Remove the tension on the Spring by rotating Knob counterclockwise to the Safe Line. This step extends the life of the spring.
- 4 Always store in a safe, dry place away from children and minors. Storing the Firing Barrel on a keychain, away from the unit, can ensure safety.

# **Commonly Asked Questions**

#### My MOLECAT® went off, but I don't see the exterminated pest. What happened?

Once the pest comes in contact with the Trigger, a powerful blast blows the pest back into the run. 95% of the time you will not see the pest near the surface point. Typically, the pest is 3 to 5 feet back in the tunnel.

#### My Trigger is not as sensitive as it should be, what is wrong?

Be sure to point the Trigger Triangle straight down when setting (steps 1-4). There are four screws on the black sleeve, these can be turned too tight.

#### Why do you need the Scent Free Bag?

Rotate the SFB inside out to eliminate your scent given off to the pest, this also protects the unit from soil and water penetration. The SFB also enlarges the triggering area so if the pest comes from the side, tension from the SFB will activate the trigger.

#### What sequence do you release the safeties?

The white Safety ring should be rotated first, allowing a pathway for the Trigger Lever to slide up. The knob is then rotated counter clockwise from the Safe line (first silver ring) to the Fire line (second silver ring).

My MOLECAT® activated, but only left a dent in the cartridge. Why didn't the device fire? The Knob controls the power of the internal hammer. Please make sure to rotate the knob to the fire line (second silver ring). Now the hammer has maximum power to strike and fire the cartridge. Please refer to step #14.

#### How can I increase the power of my MOLECAT®?

The Bunker Blaster is available for customers who desire more power. This magnum barrel replaces the stock barrel on the device and adds two times the power.

If any .27 blanks are being shipped individually or as part of the Molecat unit, they must be shipped to us by UPS ground service, prepaid. This limited warranty is void and is of no force or effect with respect to any defect unless, within 90 days from the date of purchase of the alleged defective Products, Customer delivers to Seller at Molecat LLC, 11243 S. Beutel Rd, Oregon City, OR 97045 a written claim fully describing the defect. Any suit for defective Products must be filed with a competent court as provided in paragraph 13 below within one year of the date of purchase.
- 6. Return of Products Purchased from Retail Store. Products purchased by Customer at a retail store must be returned to the store in accordance with the store's then current return policy. Products returned to us in error will be returned to Customer at Customer's cost and expense.
- 7. Return of Products Purchased Direct from Seller/Restocking Fee.

In the event that Customer shall fail to defend the claim within a reasonable time, Seller shall be entitled to assume the defense thereof with counsel of Seller's choice, and Customer shall be liable to repay Seller for all Seller's expenses reasonably incurred in connection with said defense, including reasonable attorney fees, costs, and settlement payments.
- 13. Interpretation, Jurisdiction, Venue. These terms and conditions and all other agreements between Seller and Customer shall in all respects be governed, construed and interpreted by the laws of the State of Oregon. Customer consents to and submits to the jurisdiction of all state and federal courts in Oregon. Customer agrees that venue for any action or proceeding shall be conducted in the state circuit court located in Clackamas County, Oregon, or in any federal courts located in Multnomah County, Oregon.
- 14. Attorney Fees. If Seller hires an attorney to enforce or interpret these terms and conditions, or any other agreement with Customer, Customer agrees to pay Seller's attorneys' fees and costs. The prevailing party in any action or proceeding to enforce or interpret these terms and conditions or any other agreement between the parties will be entitled to costs and reasonable attorneys' fees, at trial and on appeal; and the costs of collecting any judgment obtained including any costs or reasonable attorneys' fees incurred in any bankruptcy proceeding.
- **15. Severability.** If any term or provision of these terms and conditions is held by any court or other competent authority to be illegal or unenforceable, the remaining terms and provisions shall not be affected.
- **16. Not Assignable.** This warranty applies to the original Customer only and is not transferrable or assignable. Should the Customer transfer, sell, distribute, or otherwise dispose of the Products, the warranty becomes void.
- 17. Entire Agreement. Except to the extent the parties otherwise agree in writing, these terms and conditions are the exclusive expression of the understanding of the parties in connection with the Products.
